“We will have people migrating down the hill even in the good year they migrate down the hill with their cattle, because their grazing lands at lower elevations. We would try to however, reduce migrations that are forced upon people due to a lack of subsistence or any means of acquiring food, we would try to reduce migration in search of food, and one of the ways were doing that is by pre-positioning at higher elevations, over 3000 feet, so when people do need food they will have it there available. “
